

● [Logistics Hiring Contributes 10% of October U.S. Job Growth](#)

Hiring in the transportation and warehousing sector soared in October as employers heading into peak shipping season added 24,800 jobs, the biggest monthly gain since December and accounting for nearly 10% of total U.S. job growth. Parcel-delivery firms that bring packages to homes and business added 7,600 positions last month, as did warehousing and storage companies, according to preliminary figures the Labor Department released Friday.

Amazon.com Inc announced Tuesday New York City and a Northern Virginia suburb of Washington D.C., would be homes for the company's second and third headquarters, ending a more than yearlong public contest that began with 238 candidates and ended with a split of its so-called HQ2. Amazon said it will invest \$5 billion across the two new offices that will each have more than 25,000 employees in New York City's Long Island City and in Arlington, Va., at the National Landing area, which encompasses Crystal City and is located in the Washington, D.C., metro area.

Boeing Co (BA.N) delivered 43 of its best-selling 737 single aisle aircraft in October, up from 37 a year ago, helped by strong demand in a booming jet aircraft market and putting it on track for another year of record deliveries. The planemaker's total deliveries for the first 10 months of 2018 now stand at 625, up from 610 in the same period a year ago.
