Paint and coatings maker PPG Industries Inc. Said higher prices and cost cuts weren't enough to cover rising expenses for its ingredients. Pittsburgh-based PPG reported Thursday that adjusted earnings per share dropped to \$1.45 in its third quarter from \$1.52 a year before. Chief executive Michael McGarry said the company will continue to raise prices to cover costs.

Hasbro Still Feels Sting From Loss of Toys 'R' Us Business

The demise of Toys 'R' Us is forcing manufacturers to confront the complexities of selling billions of dollars worth of Barbie dolls, Nerf blasters and other playthings at thousands of new locations. Hasbro Inc.'s first quarter after the toy retailer's liquidations showed just how hard it will be to adapt. The Pawtucket, R.I. based oy company on Monday said the disappearance of Toys 'R' Us not only damped demand, leading to a 12% drop in third quarter sales.
